The Studio in a School Association is proud to present *Young Visions 2022: Artwork from Studio in a School*, an exhibition hosted by our cultural partner, Christie's New York. With over 200 vibrant artworks, this exhibition highlights the outstanding artistic achievements of students from Studio in a School's visual arts education programs. Studio serves children and teens from pre-school through twelfth grade at New York City public schools and community-based organizations in all five boroughs. We are elated to include artwork from students in Studio programs in Cleveland, Ohio, and Newark, New Jersey. This marks a first for Studio, after expanding in-school programming to new cities in 2016 through the Studio Institute.

Working with Studio Artist Instructors, students observe, imagine, and interpret the people, places, and things that make up their lives. *Young Visions 2022* showcases students' development of skills and capacities as reflected in their artistic choices. Beyond the artworks included here, this exhibition honors the effort, learning, growth, and creativity of every child who participated in Studio's programs this year.

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues, the visual arts remain more vital than ever, providing children with much-needed opportunities for social and emotional growth and an outlet to explore their feelings and experiences. Throughout the pandemic, Christie's partnered with Studio to produce digital exhibitions. *Young Visions 2022* is especially meaningful as our first in-person exhibition with Studio since 2019. The exhibition brings together exceptional student artworks from the schools and communities Studio proudly works with. Seen collectively, these artworks powerfully underscore the joy, curiosity, imagination, and promise of the city's next generation.

We are immensely grateful to our Studio Artist Instructors for their hard work and dedication during a challenging year as New York City's schools returned to in-person instruction. We are so proud of how our Artist Instructors, school partners, and students have navigated this transition. We hope this exhibition will bring joy to everyone who sees it.

## Art and Activism

Art is a powerful way to express ideas and emotions, to take action and stand up against injustice. Through Studio in a School NYC's Art and Activism curriculum, students learn to think critically about the world around them, to give voice to their unique perspectives, and to understand the perspectives of others.

In the lower grade curriculum, students created oil pastel self-portraits that reflect close observation, depicting what is unique and beautiful about their own skin, hair, and facial features, while learning what is unique and beautiful about others. This unit supports students' self-awareness, confidence, pride, and positive social identities, while also encouraging their awareness of and appreciation for human diversity.

In the middle school curriculum, students created collages that explore and express multiple aspects of their identities. They learned how to create impactful designs that express who they are, using the medium of collage. Through sharing and discussing each other's work, students built empathy, respect, understanding, and connection.

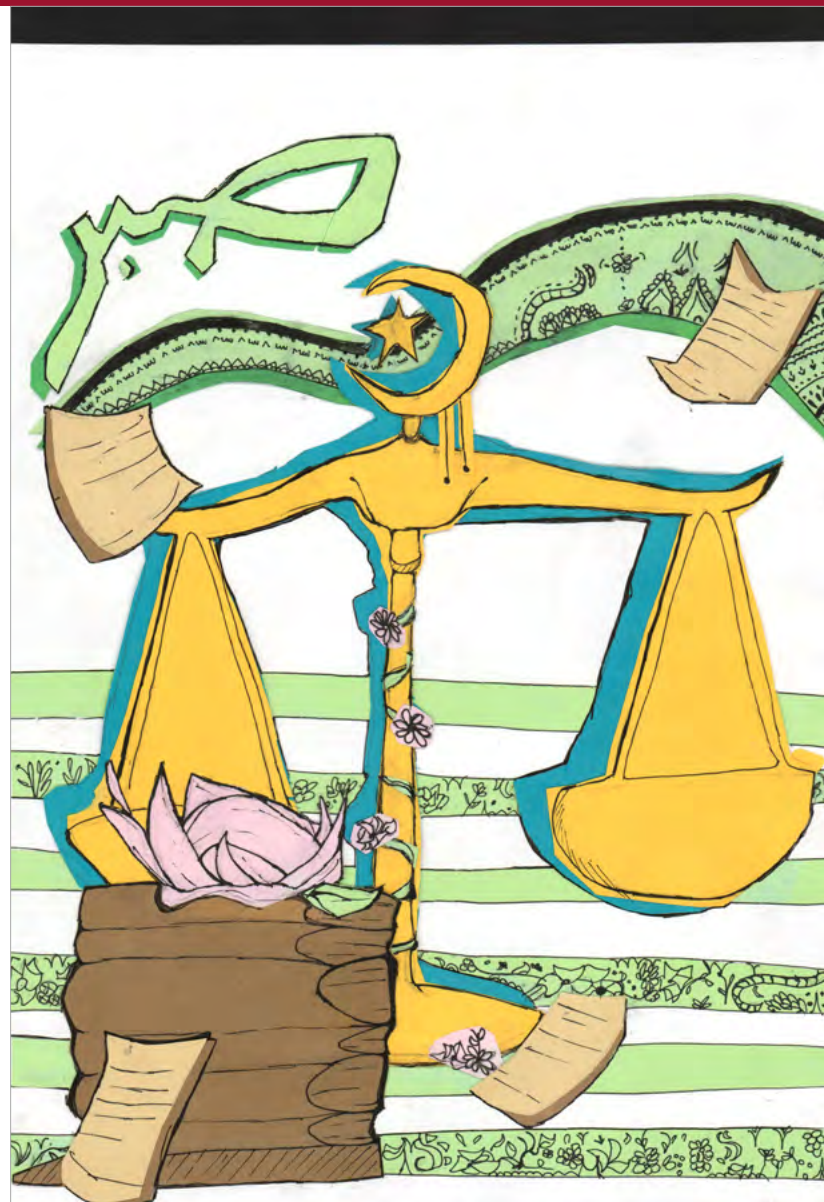

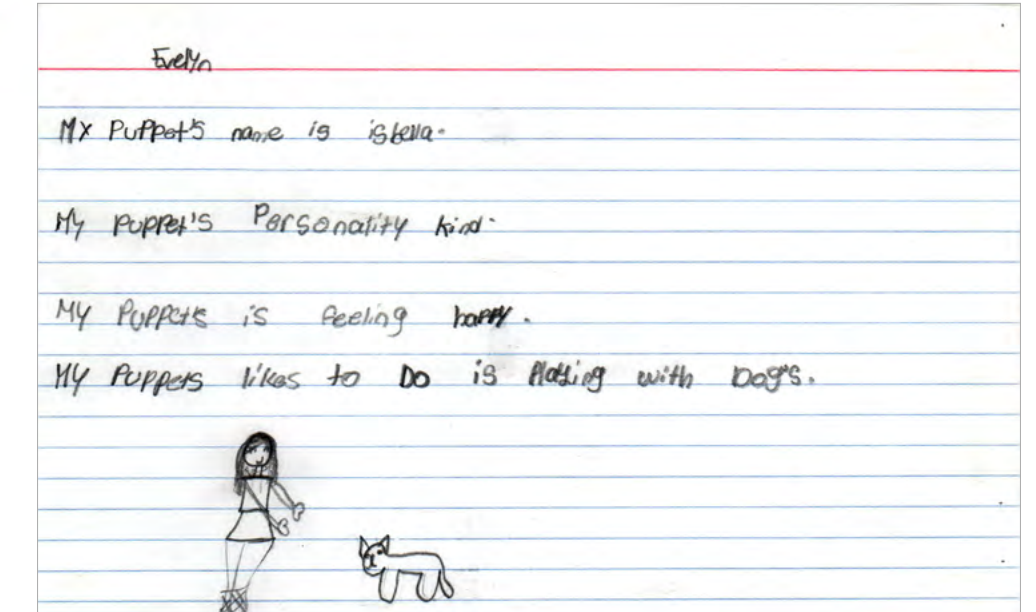

## MLL Art Lab

Studio NYC's Multilingual Learner (MLL) Art Lab was designed to support the language acquisition skills of Multilingual Learners, who comprise 13% of all NYC students. We employed a co-teaching and co-planning model that integrates language supports into our lessons and reserves a separate day for reflective discussion each week, using visual art as a shared experience and entry point for students who are new to English. Art lessons were aligned with age-appropriate benchmarks in the Blueprint for Teaching and Learning in the Visual Arts; the reflection day included lessons developed to further rich language skills and rigorous inquiry through related close looking at works of art, sketching, writing, and discussion. Our work has demonstrated that these strategies and approaches are highly effective for all learners.

We are grateful for our close partnership with the New York City Department of Education Office of Arts and Special Projects and funding from New York Community Trust, and the New York City Department of Cultural Affairs and City Council.



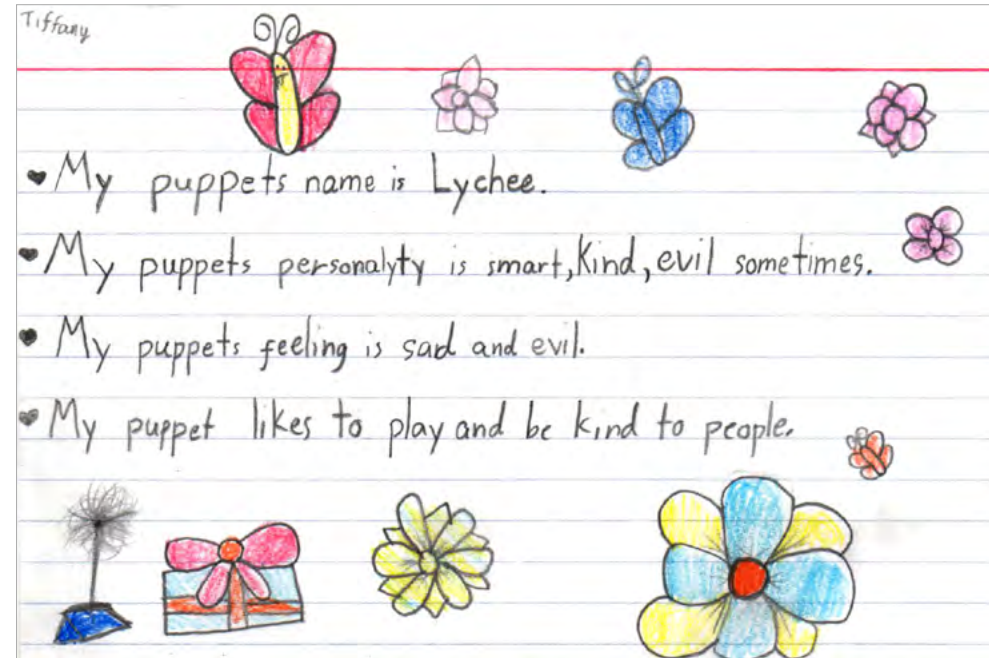
